Think of: connecting a gear lever with a vehicle model using the CAN protocol such that it can be used in a Simulink vehicle model running on a dSPACE hard real-time system.

The Junior Systems Engineer reports on progress to the Lead Engineer of the respective project.

The ideal candidate will be motivated, flexible and pragmatic. You must be willing to travel globally and work autonomously as well as in a team. You are eager to learn and have analytical thinking and problem-solving skills.

## Responsibilities & duties

- Research, specify and design simulator systems according to requirements;
- Commissioning of simulators;
- Building support, testing and evaluation of (proto-type) simulator systems;
- Create layout designs for simulators in the context of the end user's facility;
- Create internal and end user documentation;
- Be an integral part of the project team (e.g. on-site commissioning of simulator).
- Manage your own schedule and deadlines and communicate conflicts.
